

EMPOWERED COMMUNITIES. YOUTH & ENTREPRENEURSHIP

ChildFund youth development program includes career guidance and counselling for youth to support them to determine their career plans. Youth who have selected self-employment as their career path will be directed to follow this entrepreneurship skill development program. These youth entrepreneurs will receive career guidance to pursue self employment opportunities focusing on emerging industry sectors as well as access to potential local and export markets.

EQUAL OPPORTUNITIES FOR ALL.

DISABILITY INCLUSION

Socio-economic Inclusion of Persons with Disabilities in Sri Lanka through Community Based Inclusive Development (CBID) – Phase II project is currently on going and expects to reach 40,667 Person with Disabilities (PWDs) which is equivalent to 30% of estimated number of PWDs within the targeted Districts. Majority of this target population include Children and Youth with disabilities (CWD, and YWD) while the other proportion of PWDs are from other age groups.

In addition, the project will have direct benefits to the caregivers of PWDs as well. The objective of this project to provide quality vocational trainings and life skills trainings, build strong and sustainable disabled persons organizations to deliver services and refer PwDs and caregivers to the service providers, including employers and private sector and finally to effectively advocate for rights of PwDs with extensive engagement with employers and private sector. We are looking for corporate organizations to partner with as recourse persons and linking up employment opportunities for the trained youth.



ACCESS TO RESOURCES.

WATER AND SANITATION

Water scarcity is a major issue in many parts of Batticaloa due to the lack of infrastructure which resulted from the civil conflict in the north and east. We identified 30 schools that require and currently lacking water and sanitation facilities. The lack of safe sanitation facilities impacts the students negatively especially for female students as well as teachers. Most of the toilet facilities do not have doors or locks while others don't have the water connectivity.

Also during the COVID19 context, lack of water and sanitation plays a major risk for schools which are now fully operating. Through public funding we hope to renovate and establish the facilities at these 30 schools and conduct awareness on proper use of sanitation facilities, the COVID19 safety awareness and the importance of access to clean water.



GO BEYOND.

DIGITAL LEARNING IN THE POST COVID19 CONTEXT

Childfund is committed to support children's education and we recognize digital learning schemes including blended and E-learning will be the future of most of our programmes focused on disseminating knowledge and uplifting the education standards with the communities we work with.

This specific project will act as a steppingstone for our work to experiment and incorporate these modern modes of education with our development work. We see digital learning as a window of opportunity to create efficient and holistic programmes for the future of our development work in Sri Lanka.

DISASTER RESPONSE AND ENVIRONMENT PROTECTION

Eco Systems Based Disaster Risk Reduction (ECO DRR) projects where youth groups get together and develop plans for their villages and present to Government authorities and practically implement while taking the ownership of these initiatives back to the communities.

We also focus on specific requirements aligning with the sustainability strategies of our corporate partners to tailor make environmental projects linking the activities up with schools and youth groups.
